



MASSES FOR VARIOUS NEEDS & OCCASIONS

“If any case of a graver need or of pastoral advantage should arise, at the direction of the Diocesan Bishop or with his permission, an appropriate Mass may be celebrated on any day except Solemnities, the Sundays of Advent, Lent, and Easter, days within the Octave of Easter, the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls’ Day), Ash Wednesday, and the days of Holy Week.” [GIRM 374]

Please note that during this time of Lent Archbishop Sample has given permission to use these three Masses from the selection of Masses and Prayers for Various Needs and Occasions in the Roman Missal:

1. For the Nation or State [21]
2. For the Sick [45]
3. In any Need [48]

In the Extraordinary Form Archbishop Sample has determined that the following Ordered Prayers (*Orationes Imperatae*) can be used at the priest’s discretion according to the rubrics of the Liturgical Books of 1962. [cf. O’Connell pp.113-114]

1. Pro Mortalitatibus [23 *Missa Votiva*]
2. Pro Infirmis [26 *Missa Votiva*]
3. Pro Quacumque Necessitate [20 *Orationes Diversae*]
4. In Quacumque Tribulatione [21 *Orationes Diversae*]
